





### **Student Application to UBI MBA Programme**

### **Checklist of programme application**

#### 1. A complete application form. (APPLY NOW)

- 2. An undergraduate degree academic transcript and supplement from a recognised institution, with two years of management work experience (or a minimum of five years of management work experience, if you did not study for an undergraduate degree)
- 3. A **250-word (minimum) essay\*** on one topic of student's choice, among the following:
  - Describe the biggest risk you have taken in your life and report what you learnt from this experience.
  - Evaluate and illustrate your ability to set and achieve goals.
  - Describe your biggest achievement and outline the reasons for your success.
- 4. Two recommendation letters
- 5. a **CV**
- 6. Proof of **identity** in the form of either passport or national ID card, and an ID photograph.
- 7. Other academic requirements as may be deemed necessary (Skype interview)



### **Student Application to UBI MBA Programme**

### **Checklist of programme application**

#### **Proficiency in English** (see below)

- To ensure the students' study experience at UBI is of the highest standards, a minimum English fluency level is required upon admission. Applicants must submit one of the following proofs to represent one's English level:
- Grade C at GCSE or equivalent;
- Graduated from an English-taught undergraduate programme;
- IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL 575 (paper-based) / 90 (internet-based);
- Cambridge English Advanced (a.k.a. Certificate in Advanced English): grade C\*
- Cambridge English Business (Vantage): high score at the B level, ideally A\*
- Cambridge English Business (Higher): grade C\*
- Cambridge English Proficiency (a.k.a. Certificate of Proficiency in English): any grade\*

\* score on the Cambridge English scale of no less than 176

### Student Application to UBI **Bachelor Programme**

#### **Checklist of Requirements**

- 1. A complete application form. (option on the right: <u>APPLY NOW</u>)
- 2. High School Diploma (European or non-European) with the detailed curriculum (summary of the programme syllabus) and marks/grades
- 3. A **250-word (minimum) essay\*** on the topic of your choice, among the following:
  - Describe the biggest risk you have taken in your life and report what you learnt from this experience.
  - Evaluate and illustrate your ability to set and achieve goals.

\* Please note it is essential to devote time and effort to this short essay, as it is an essential part of the entry criteria. Only the candidates who have shown leadership potential, a passion for studying/willingness to reach study goals, an entrepreneurial spirit, or a track record of community service will proceed to the next part of the selection process.

- 4. Proof of identity in the form of a photocopy of either passport or national ID card, and 2 ID photographs.
- English Proficiency Test 5.
- 6. Other academic requirements as may be deemed necessary.

All non-English or French files need to be sent together with translation files.



- 1. On successful application student will receive the "UBI admission offer letter"
- 2. To confirm the offer acceptance, students need to reply with confirmation and pay a nonrefundable administrative deposit of 250 Euro + first semester (part-time) tuition of 5,450 Euro to UBI bank account.
- 3. UBI will issue the "proof of admissions" document upon receiving the payment for students to proceed the Belgium student visa application at the local Belgian Embassy or visa <u>centre</u>.


