ABOUT EDUCATION IN RUSSIA

WHY IS IT AN AWESOME OPPORTUNITY TO STUDY IN RUSSIA?

The study in Russia is prestigious and beneficial. You may be absolutely sure of getting all necessary skills and knowledge within a chosen specialty. Russia is an enormous country where you may meet a plenty of local and international students who managed to realize their dreams within the areas of science and research. It involves a huge choice of universities specialized in various fields depending on what you would like to study.

According to the Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development, Russia is considered to be the most educated country in the world leaving behind such countries as Canada, Japan, Israel and the USA.

Russia is an incredibly diverse country and the quantity of international students is increasing day by day. The Russian are mostly kind-hearted, gentle and helpful, that is why every single student is really welcomed and respected at our universities.

The official language is Russian, however, 100 languages more are spoken in 160 ethnic groups across the country. It must be also stated that over a quarter of the world's scientific literature is published in Russian and it is also one of the six official languages of the United Nations. Having chosen to study in this country, a student has to choose the medium of instruction. It can be either Russian or English and in some cases French depending on the chosen specialty.

RUSSIAN EDUCATION SYSTEM

Secondary education in Russia is completed in 11 years instead of 12 as in many other countries.


Study from the 1st to 9th year is obligatory. After that each student can choose one of several ways to move forward. The certificate of Basic General Education received after year nine can lead on to two more years at secondary school, which gives the Certificate of Complete Secondary Education which in turn makes a student eligible for entry into higher education. Another alternative is to pursue an associate degree at a tradesman school or college lasting three years and generally leading directly on to work.

RUSSIAN HIGHER EDUCATION

Decided to study in Russia? We will tell you why you made the best choice.

Russia is recognized as the world leader in training the best mathematicians, physicists, chemists, geologist, engineers, programmers, doctors in the world. Over 800 universities in various regions of the country, over 200 programs of studying are waiting for students who are about to turn all their dreams into reality. The Russian Federation has more university graduates than any other country.

There are three basic kinds of higher education institutions – Universities, Academies, Institutes. Universities offer a wide spectrum of programs on all levels of education. Academies provide higher education at all levels and conduct a large amount of research – usually specialized in one branch such as science, art or architecture. Institutes are independent parts of universities or academies offering professional education programs.



DEGREE STRUCTURES IN RUSSIA

Higher education in Russia normally lasts between four to six years. The first four years of full time university study leads to a Bakalavr (Bachelor) degree. The completion of the course requires a research project and passing the state final exams. The Bachelor degree is awarded in all fields except medicine, where the first stage lasts for six years.

Once students have obtained their Bachelor degree, they are eligible for the entry into a Specialist Diploma and Master's degree program. In Russia, this does not count as postgraduate education, as is the case in most other countries. The master's degree is awarded after two years of study whereof one is a year of research including practice, preparation and defending of a thesis. In addition, you must also pass the final exams.

Both Bachelor's and Master's degrees are relatively new. They did not exist in the Soviet system, and were introduced to conform the Russian system toward a more international standard in accordance with the Bologna Process. This change will hopefully mean a greater recognition and acceptance of Russian degrees abroad, which was a problem for international students in the past and kept the numbers of international students down.

A Master's degree qualifies the student to enter postgraduate education. Postgraduate education is obtained at a university or scientific institute and is split in two parts. The first level usually results in a Kandidat nauk degree, which is a Candidate of Sciences. This first level is roughly equivalent to a Ph.D. in the United States.

Further postgraduate education (2-4 years) leads to a Doctor Nauk degree which then leads on to a Doctor's degree. The latter is rarely awarded to anyone below 40 as the time between these two degrees is generally around 10 years.

ACADEMIC YEAR AND SEMESTER

The academic year starts on 1st of September and ends at the end of June. It is divided into an autumn and spring semester. Study period of 16 weeks in autumn term and a study period of 15-16 weeks in spring term. Each semester ends with one assessment week, during which students take course tests and present assignment works and defend course projects. Exam session: 2 or 3 weeks' period of examinations and final assessments take place each semester.

Comprehensive University Education.

In Russia, you can acquire in-depth, fundamental knowledge in all subjects, but the country is best known for its strong academic schools in physics, mathematics and natural sciences. Russia is a recognized world leader in training mathematicians, physicists, chemists, geologists, engineers, programmers, physicians, and specialists in other natural sciences. This is confirmed by the positions of Russian universities in world rankings.

A Wide Range of Study Programmes.

205 fields, from mathematics and natural sciences to the dramatic arts; 657 subjects in Bachelor's, Master's, Specialist and Postgraduate Programmes (medical traineeships, postgraduate military courses), and internships and assistantships. Russian universities also offer preparatory programmes (training for enrolment on Bachelor's, Master's and Specialist Degree courses)

Optimum Ratio of Price and Quality of Education

Self-funded study is much cheaper at Russian universities than the equivalent in the USA, Canada and the UK, and in terms of the level of training provided, leading Russian universities compete on par with educational institutions in the West.

Opportunity to Study in English

Haven't had time to learn Russian? No problem! More and more Russian universities are offering programmes taught in English.

Opportunity to obtain internationally recognized certificates

In 2003, Russia signed the Bologna Declaration, assuming several obligations as part of the creation of a common educational space of participant countries. Diplomas of Russian universities are recognised in most countries.





Comfortable and Well-Equipped Campuses and Dormitories

In terms of study facilities, Russian universities are a match for many western universities. High-level equipment for laboratories, scientific centres and study facilities are now a reality of student life today. Most Russian universities have their own dormitories with a relatively low cost of accommodation.

Easy Adaptation for International Students

Russia is a multinational country where representatives of the most diverse countries and cultures can easily adapt to life here. Russia is home to more than 200 ethnic groups that speak more than 100 different languages and dialects. The Russian constitution guarantees freedom of conscience: Christians, Muslims, Buddhists, Judaists, and representatives of other faiths peacefully coexist here. The country is multinational and ethnic structure illustrates the diversity of all spheres of life, from cultural to domestic. Unsurprisingly, many foreigners arriving in Russia feel at home here. Russian universities are proud of their long experience in the training and acclimatisation of international students: supervisory programmes are arranged for first-year students and there is an established network of student communities.

Different Climate Zones

Russia is a vast country where you can choose not only a course of study or university, but even your preferred climate – from a moderate continental climate in the European part of the country to the subtropical Black Sea coast of the Caucasus and southern Crimea.

ADMISSION PROCESS

There are 4 steps to complete admission process at any Russian State University:



APPLY WITH US

Students may apply online. After reading the complete information on the website about tuition fees and courses, first you have to choose the course.

After choosing the course you should send us the following documents by email:

- Filled Application Form
- Copy of International Passport or ID Card (minimum valid for 2 years)
- Copy of Higher Secondary School Certificate (with subject marks)

After reviewing the above written documents, we will notify about the acceptance or rejection. If you are accepted, then we will issue the Admission Confirmation Letter in 1 working day.



GET INVITATION LETTER

To get an invitation letter from any University of Russia, we require the following documents:

- Filled Application Form
- Copy of International Passport (minimum valid for one year)
- Copy of School Certificate (with subject marks)
- Cost of the Invitation Letter

You can send us these documents only after receiving Admission letter from RECAS. You can send us the documents via email. Please note, that documents should be scanned properly and should be clearly visible. You can make the payment via bank transfer, by Western Union or Money Gram. Please send us the receipt of payments to confirm. Invitation letters are issued by Federal Migration Service of Russia and it takes 40-45 days to issue it.



VISA & ARRIVAL

After getting the invitation letter from RECAS, student should contact the nearest Russian Embassy or Consulate in his/her country.

General Visa Requirements are the following:

- Filled Application form (you can fill in online on <http://visa.kdmid.ru>)
- Original passport (valid for 2 years min)
- Higher Secondary School certificate with transcript (attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or with the Apostille stamp)
- Aids/HIV test, should be negative (attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs)
- Official Invitation letter issued by Federal Migration Services of the Russian Federation through RECAS
- 2 Passport size photos (3.5 x 4.5)

For complete visa requirements, please contact the Embassy of the Russian Federation in your country. After getting visa from Russian Embassy or Consulate, students should inform us about his/her flight details with date and arrival time. One of our representatives will receive the student at the airport. In case student does not inform us about his/her arrival, he/she will be deported back to homeland by the Immigration Authorities of Russia.

YOU HAVE TO TRANSFER THE COMPLETE FIRST YEAR EXPENSES BEFORE ARRIVAL

IN THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION. Before arrival you have to send us the payment receipt of complete first year expenses paid.



START YOUR CLASSES!

Every Student should bring with him/her a complete set of original documents.

It is compulsory for every student to be registered at the University in three working days after the arrival in the Russian Federation territory. After the Arrival in Russia, a student should submit the complete documents and first year complete charges as written in the Admission Confirmation Letter to International Department. Staff of International Relations office will complete the admission and registration process in 1-3 working days and after that they will allow you to start the classes. International Office will also extend the visa from Home Office. International Office staff will complete all the formalities that you should start your classes in 4-5 working days.

CHECHEN STATE UNIVERSITY



Chechen State University dates back to 7 February 1938 when Grozny Teacher Training Institute was founded with a two-year study period. Later in 2011 the University transformed into the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Professional Education "Chechen State University".

Currently around 15000 full-time and part-time students are receiving education at Chechen State University and 10 Faculties and four Institutes lead the learning process. The Centre of Collective Use at the University serves as a launch pad for the staff and students to conduct research in priority development areas of science and technology as well as providing services to external organizations and individuals on a commercial basis.

Educational Process is organized using modern technologies. The classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards, hardware essential for videoconferences. Extensive resources of online-library, both Russian and international databases are at students' service. The university offers different areas of training in specialist's, bachelor's and master's programs, as well as postgraduate course.



ABOUT GROZNY CITY

Grozny is the capital city of Chechnya, Russia. Grozny was founded in 1818, when the fortress Groznaya was built. It was the military outpost of the Russian Empire that played an important role during the Caucasian War. Grozny city climate is temperate continental with mild winters, long and hot summers. The average temperature in January is -3 degrees Celsius, in July - +23 degrees C. Large-scale reconstruction of the city was carried out in recent years. The airport "Grozny" offers flights to Moscow.





ABOUT CITY

Grozny is the capital city of Chechnya, Russia. The city lies on the Sunzha River. For administrative purposes, the city is divided into four city districts: Leninsky, Zavodskoy, Staropromyslovsky, and Oktyabrsky. Oktyabrsky District hosts most of the city's industry. The city is served by Grozny Airport. The airport "Grozny" ("Severniy") is located about five kilometers from the city center. It mainly serves regular daily flights from Moscow. Such modes of transport as trains, trolley-buses, trams are also available in the city. The railway station of Grozny serves daily trains Moscow - Grozny and Volgograd - Grozny. The most common means of transportation around the city are buses. There are three universities in the capital: Chechen State University, Chechen State Pedagogical University and Grozny State Oil Technical University. Grozny has a humid continental climate with hot summers and cold winters.

ABOUT GSOTU

Grozny State Oil Technical University was founded in 1920 as the Higher Petroleum Technical School, consisting of eight divisions, two of which were higher. Among the graduates of the institute



are five Heroes of Socialist Labor, ministers of the petrochemical and oil refining industries of the USSR. At present, the material and technical base of the institute consists of buildings that meet the requirements and standards of the educational process, provided with computer classes and modern educational laboratories. There are 30 laboratories and 15 computer classes in all faculties of the institute. All buildings of the university are connected to global internet, access to which, thanks to a developed local network, is possible from any computer at the institute. The library of the institute is equipped with the necessary technical means for storing and issuing books. Today, the general book fund of the institute is about 250,000 copies. For 85 years, Grozny Oil Technical University has trained more than 50 000 specialists for various sectors of the national economy of Russia. The educational process at the university is carried out by about 550 teachers, including 15 doctors of science, 70 candidates of science, 30 professors, 75 associate professors. The institute trains about 6,500 students, including more than 3,500 full-time students. Over the past five years, the institute has graduated more than 3,000 specialists, 150 of whom received diplomas with honors. All classrooms of the university are well-furnished and equipped with interactive whiteboards, computers and other facilities which are necessary for successful studying. During breaks our students may have set lunch or dinner in the canteens which are available in our educational establishment and are characterized by a great variety of food.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is one of the most significant factors when it comes to living and studying abroad. The students of Grozny State Oil Technical University are provided with rooms for 2-3 people. All rooms are cozy, well-equipped and comfortable to live. A bed, a mattress, a pillow, a blanket, a desk, chairs as well as access to Internet are given to every single Student at the University. It is located in 10-15 minutes' walk from most shops, cafes etc. The university hostel has 5 floors which are equipped with everything you need: toilets, spacious washrooms with soap dispensers, kitchens with electric stoves and ovens, kitchen furniture and dishwashing detergent. There are 2 types of rooms that can accommodate 170 students in total.

Double rooms include features as private WC, shower, kitchen and balcony;

Suite-style rooms are divided into several categories:

- double and triple rooms share such amenities as WC, shower and kitchen with another room.
- 5-person suite is comprised of one double room and one triple room that are connected by a shared private hallway, WC, kitchen, shower and balcony.

They had a round head, a wide muzzle, a slightly convex forehead, a large large neck, a developed shoulder girdle and a short tail.
3. Kazan is one of the most equipped cities in Russia in terms of sports infrastructure. In 2009, during an online survey, Russians recognized it as the country's sports capital.
4. Kazan is the oldest metropolis not only in Russia, but also perhaps the oldest city in Eastern Europe, second only to Prague and Kiev.
5. Not far from Kazan, the Blue Lakes are located - a popular vacation spot for residents and visitors of the city. Bodies of water from 2 to 18 meters deep feed on groundwater and do not freeze in winter. The water in them is characterized by absolute transparency, high salt content.



ACCOMMODATION



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

Rybinsk has a furniture and wood products combine and plants that produce plastic goods, leather and optical glass. It is the site of a 330-megawatt hydroelectric power plant. It has an aviation technology institute, aviation and printing colleges, medical and pedagogical schools, and school for river navigation. HOSTEL



PEOPLES' FRIENDSHIP UNIVERSITY OF RUSSIA

On 22nd February, 1961, the RUDN University was named after Patrice Lumumba — one of the symbols of the African peoples' fight for independence. 

AWARDS

MIPT is perhaps one of the most awarded university in Russia. In the course of MIPT's history 10 of its professors and alumni have been awarded Nobel Prize, the most recent one being given in 2010 for discovering graphene. In addition, Phystech's very own researchers and professors have received the Dirac medal, Fundamental Physics Prize, and the BBVA Foundation Award, among many others.




CHAIRS

MIPT education is divided into 12 chairs, covering a wide range of knowledge fields in fundamental and applied science, including general and applied physics, life sciences, space research, nanotechnology, aerophysics, radio and flight engineering, molecular physics, quantum electronics, innovation, system engineering and more

LABORATORIES AND RESEARCH CENTERS

There are over 50 laboratories at MIPT which conduct research in different fields of science, both fundamental and applied study. All of them are highly equipped and has every opportunity to create and develop. Heads of the laboratories are involved in educational process as well as students are involved in scientific research. The majority of MIPT's labs teams consist of university's professors, students and alumni. Many of them participate in international collaborations and has exchange programs.





HOSTELS
